SCIENCE, WORLD ARTS & MORE!


In 7th grade math, they have built their Personal Preference Kits to bring their personal belongings to the moon.






BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Vanilla Mug Cake

Ingredients:

- 4 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 4 tablespoons milk
- 1 1/2 tablespoons oil
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract
- sprinkles (optional)

Donut holes

Ingredients:

- All-purpose flour
- Baking powder
- Salt
- Buttermilk: We don't recommend substitutes here, the milk and vinegar substitute isn't quite thick enough.
- Granulated sugar
- Melted butter
- Vegetable oil: Needed for frying.

Instructions:

Preheat oil in a deep saute pan or pot over medium heat.

Whisk together flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.

In a separate bowl or measuring cup, whisk together buttermilk and melted butter.

Add the dry ingredients to the wet and stir until just combined Gently roll dough into 1/2 tbsp size balls.

Carefully place dough balls into the preheated oil (frying about half of them at a time) and fry until golden brown on both sides. Use a spider strainer to transfer to paper towels, then let drain and roll in sugar.

Enjoy!

Instructions:

- In a microwavable mug whisk together the flour, sugar, and baking powder.
- Add in the milk, oil, and vanilla and mix until just combined. Stir in the sprinkles.
- Microwave for roughly 45 seconds 1 minute, or until firm to the touch.
- Serve warm with frosting, ice cream or cream. Enjoy
