

What is ELAC?

Every public school with twenty-one or more English learners must form an English Learner Advisory Committee. The Committee is responsible for advising the school on programs and services for English learners as well as provide input on the School Plan.

What are the responsibilities as an ELAC member?

- Attend 5 to 6 meetings per year from 3:00pm to 4:00pm
- Attend the Evergreen School District training and dinner on October 16, 2019 at 5:30 in the Teacher Center at the District Office
- The ELAC shall be responsible for advising administration and staff on programs and services for English learners and the School Site Council on the development of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)
- The ELAC shall assist the school in the development of:
 - The school's needs assessment
 - Ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance
- Elect on member of ELAC to the District English Language Advisory committee (DELAC)
