



What is School Site Council?

Every school that receives school improvement funding must have a School Site Council to develop, implement, and oversee a School Improvement Plan for Student Achievement.

What are the responsibilities as a School Site Council member?

- Attend 6 to 7 meetings per year from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm
- Attend District School Site Council training on October 3, 2018 at LeyVa from 6-7pm
- Assist in the development of the school plan
- Approve and recommend the plan for the Board of Trustees' approval
- Review the ongoing implementation of the school plan
- Monitor the effectiveness of the improvement activities in meeting the specific objectives stated in the plan
- Review and update the plan annually
- This is a two year term
