  - Presentation by Mrs. Hansen-Vera:
    - a) socio-economic status affects student performance in Language Arts
    - b) Quimby is focusing on improving the scores of our socio-economically disadvantaged students
    - c) Quimby's Latino students: regardless of socio-economic status, performance is low.
    - d) Compare youth truth survey to SES survey:
      - (1) high relationships with teacher-student relationships district wide; at Quimby we give our students the opportunity to make positive relationships and foster them through electives, clubs, sports, and restorative justice.
    - e) Student engagement and rigor are affected by teacher-student relationship; the stronger the bond, the higher the engagement in class.
    - f) Parents want to feel validated and more roles in the Quimby campus.



- g) Parent community knows that the teachers are working really hard to create rigorous curriculum and care about their students.
- h) Focused on enhancing the emotional enhancement of quimby community; making sure our students have resources (i.e. a counselor); making sure teachers have support to grow using restorative justice.
